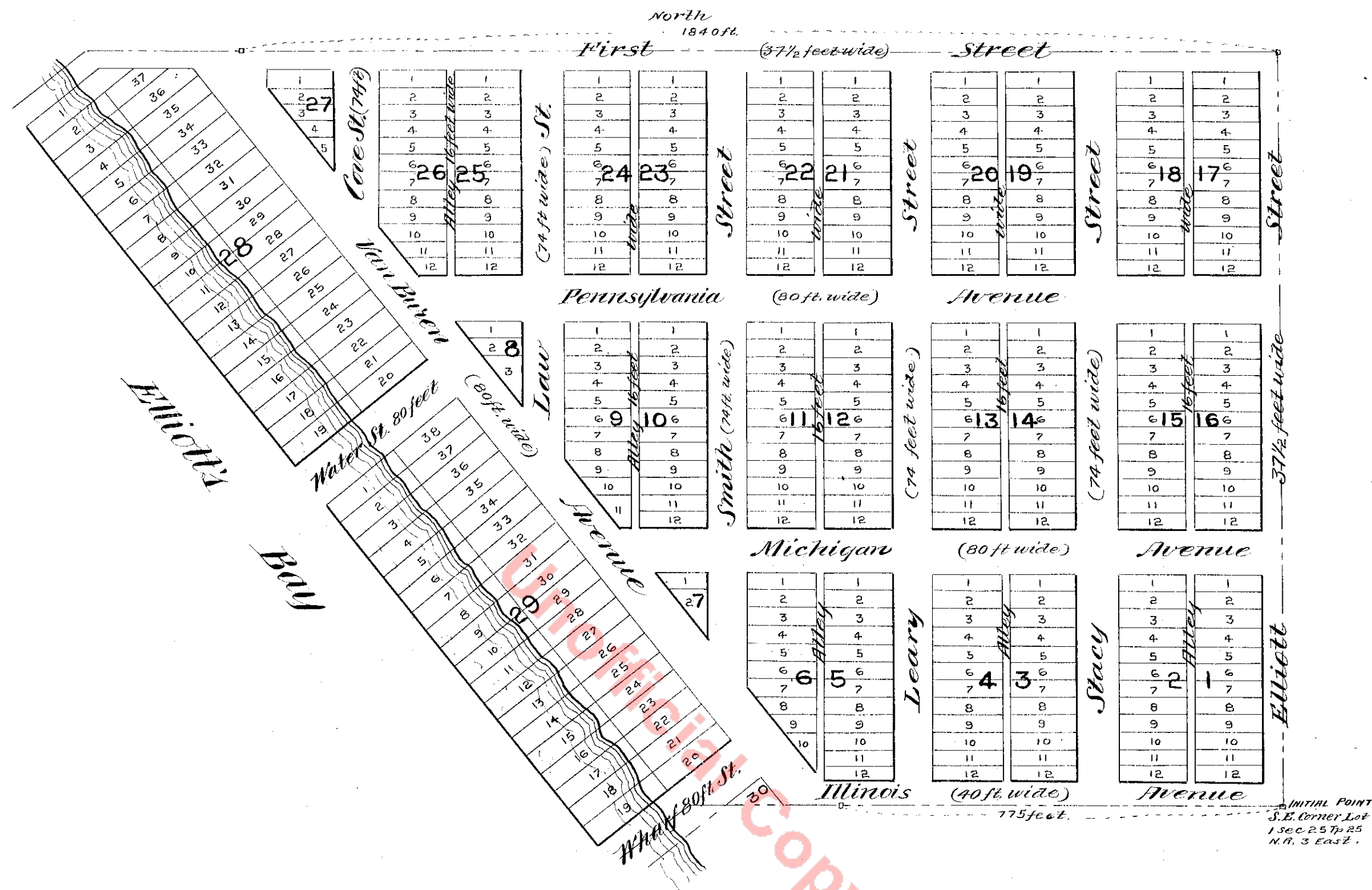


# Northern Addition To Seattle, W.T.



This Addition is laid out upon and embraces all of lot One (1) of Section Twenty Five (25) in Township Twenty Five (25) North of Range No Three (3) East, in King County Washington Territory. The Streets, Avenues and Alleys are in width as represented on this plat, and run North and South, East and West, except Van Buren Avenue, The eastern line of which commences on the South boundary line of said Lot One in Section 25, Seven hundred and Seventy Five feet, west from the South East corner of said lot, and runs thence in a North Westerly direction until said Eastern line intersects the North Boundary line of said lot One at a point Eighteen hundred and forty feet, West from the North East corner of said lot One in section Twenty five, and Water and wharf streets which run at right angles with Van Buren Avenue, and in Block 28, 29 Lots are 40 feet by 150 feet each, Lots are 30 feet wide and one hundred and Twenty feet deep, except where they are made fractional by Van Buren Avenue.

Now Know all men by these presents, That we James M<sup>c</sup> Naught and Agnes M<sup>c</sup> Naught, have laid out and platted said lot One in Section Twenty Five in Township Twenty Five (25) North of Range Three, (3) East into Blocks, Lots, Streets, Avenues and Alleys as represented on this Plat, and we do hereby grant and donate, for the use of the Public forever, all the land embraced in the Avenues, Streets and Alleys. Witness our hands and seals this 25<sup>th</sup> day of January A. D. 1875.
