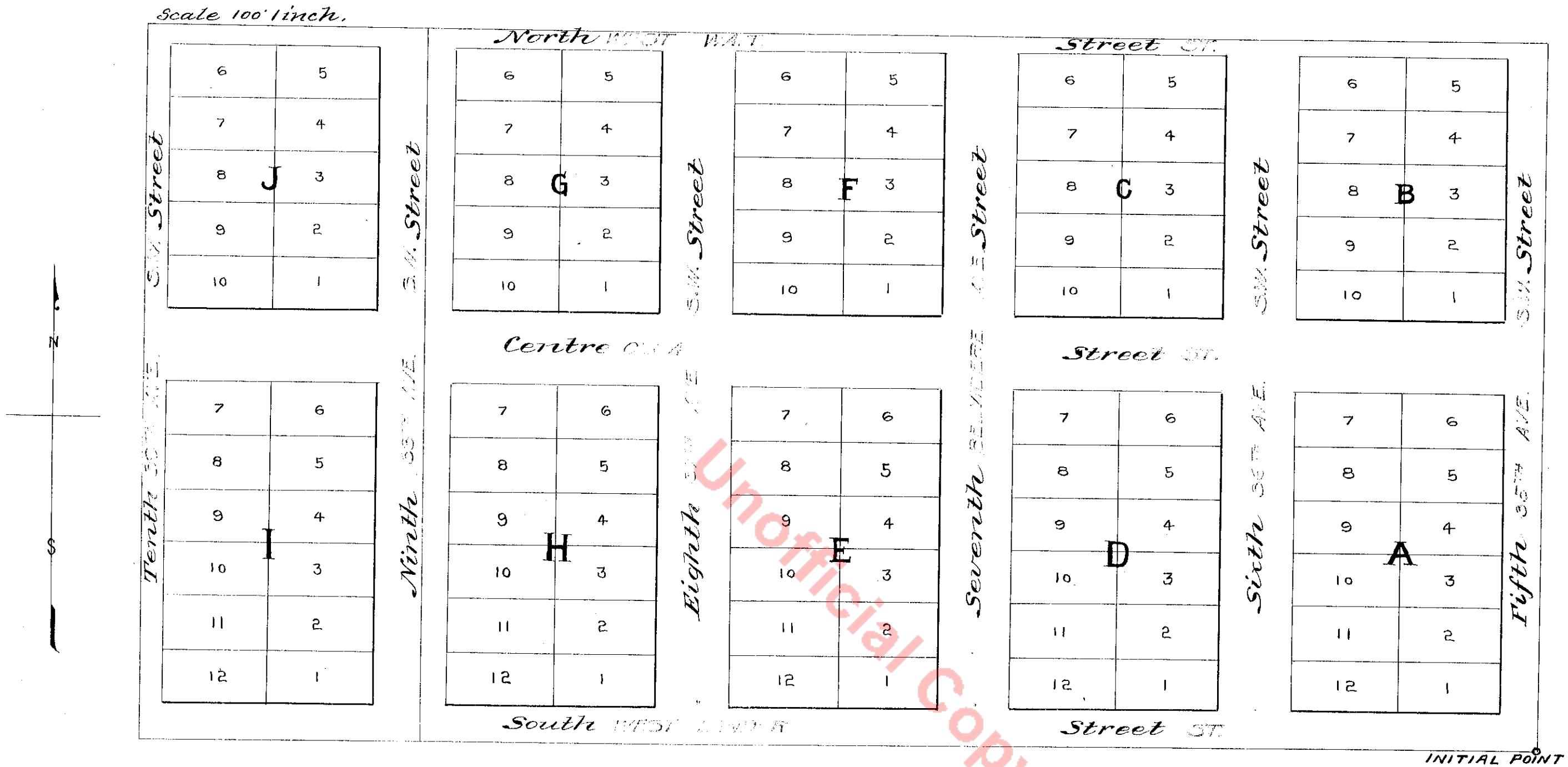


# Plat of Wheeler's Western Addition TO SEATTLE, KING COUNTY, W. T. Y.
