Known as mine by them parents
Had Mr John M. Kollock and

Margaret M. Kollock his wife of Seattle King County Washington Territory land they placed and last out the Kollock Addition to the City of Seattle as shown by the plat and here dedicated the streets therein to leave to public use forever and section being located upon a tract of land bounded and measured as follows

Commencing at a post at the South West corner of the Grant's addition to the City of Seattle three rods in West Street 304 feet three rods West along the line of the Eastern addition to Seattle 1497 feet three rods along the line of land of W. C. Spurgeon 304 feet three rods along the line of said Grant's addition 1497 feet to the place of beginning containing 3 1/3 acres more or less, lots in Block 1 are 50 by 120 feet except lots 1 and 12 which are 54 by 120 feet, lots in Block 2 are 43 by 159 feet except lot 1 which is 46 by 159 feet.

Princes William Streets 66 feet wide and Lakes Street is 14 feet wide.
