Explanation

The lands and surrounding streets in this plat coincide with Blocks 16 and 17 in Burke's 2nd Addition to the City of Seattle and streets surrounding the same except as to the street running through Block 17 on this plat, North and South, 30 ft. wide.
All lots in Block 17 are 45 by 105 feet.
Lots 1 and 18 in Block 16 are 60 by 120 feet.
Lots 2 to 17 inclusive in Block 16 are 45 by 120 feet.
