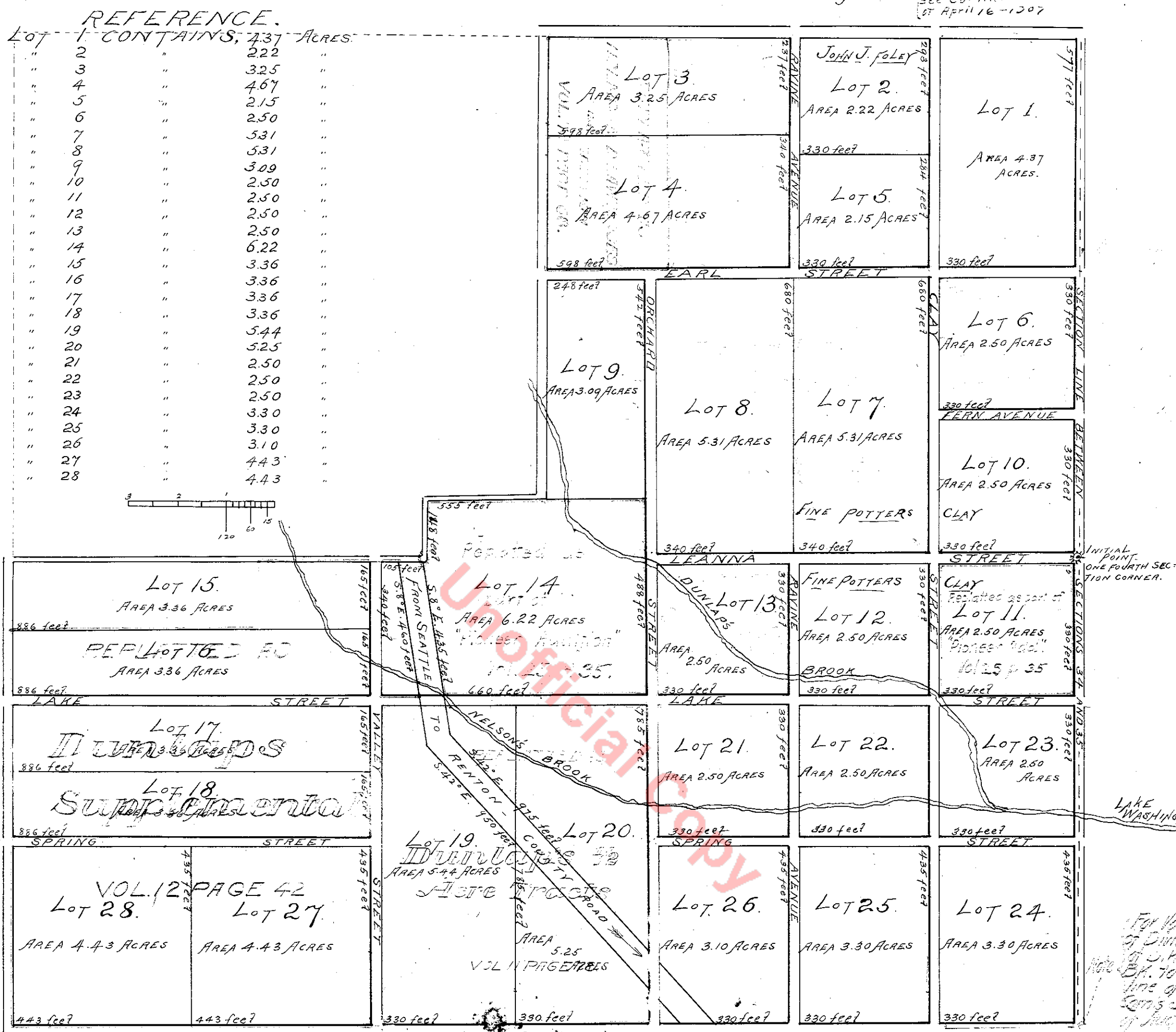


DUNLAP'S PLAT OF LAND ON LAKE WASHINGTON

The initial point is the one fourth section corner on the North and South line between Sections 34 and 35 - thus which corner is located 10 feet south and 10 feet east of the South East corner of Lot 10.

The County Road is measured as part of the surface of lots 14, 19, 20 and 26 but is not computed in their areas.

The Streets are 20 feet wide and run North and South, East and West.

The length and breadth of each lot is given on the plat in feet.
