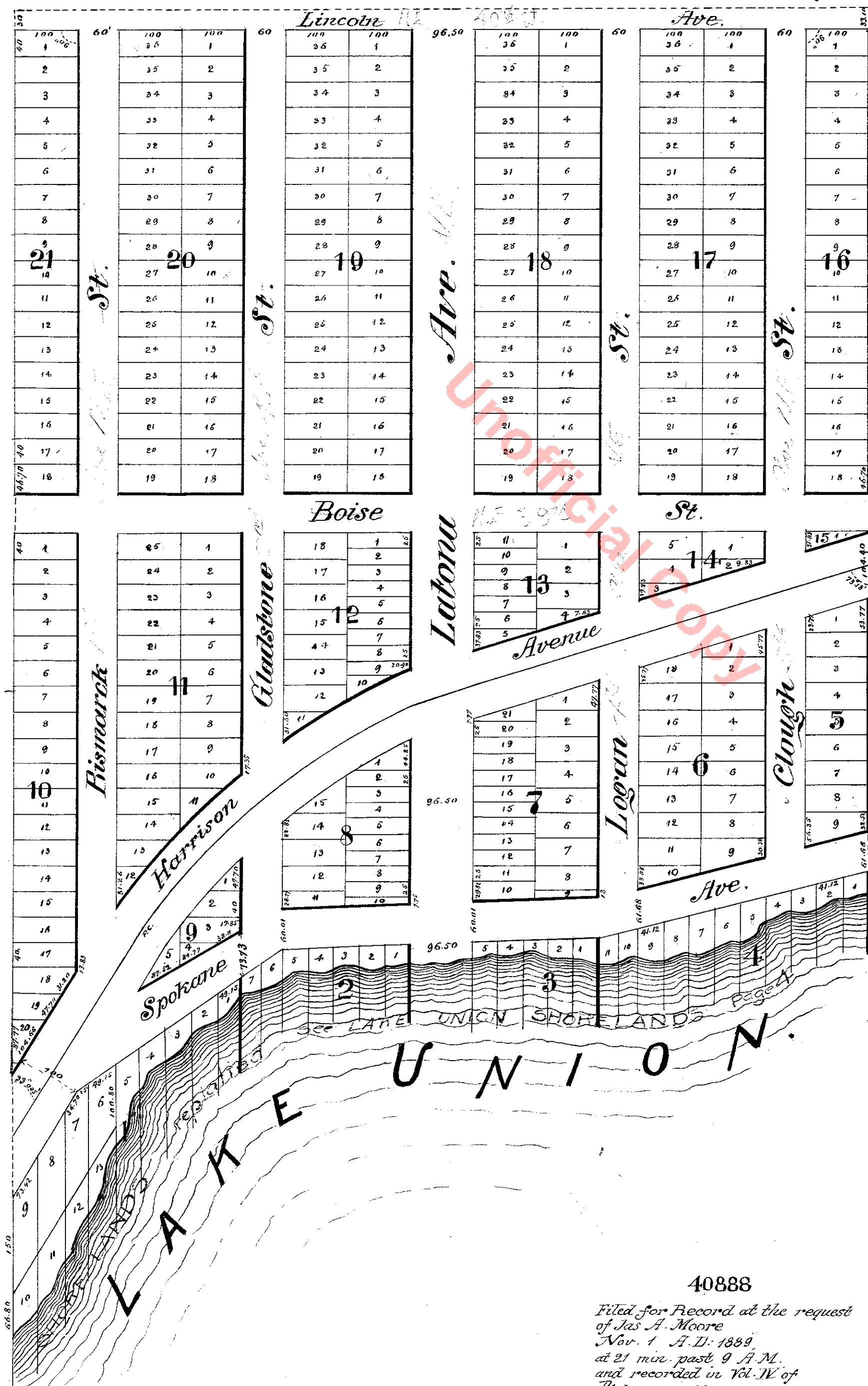


# Latona Addition

**T**HIS Latona Addition To The City of Seattle comprises all of Lot 3 of Section 17 Tp. 25 N. R. 4 E. W. M. The initial point of this plat is the North East corner of lot one (1) block sixteen (16) which is 1364.80 feet south of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section Corner between Sections 17 and 8 of Tp. 25 N. R. 4 E. Full regular lots are 40 x 100 feet. Fractional and other lots are as noted on plat. Lots in blocks 1-2-3-4 extend to deep water. Latona Avenue is 96.50 feet wide. Harrison Avenue is 100 feet wide. Lincoln Avenue is as noted on plat. All other streets are 60 ft. wide. All measurements, indicated on this plat are expressed in feet.

**K**now all men by these Presents, That we, G. Morris Haller and Annie C. Haller, wife of G. Morris Haller, of Seattle, King County, Washington Territory, owners of this Latona Addition To The City Of Seattle, hereby declare this plat, and hereby dedicate to the use of the public forever all the streets and avenues platted thereon.
