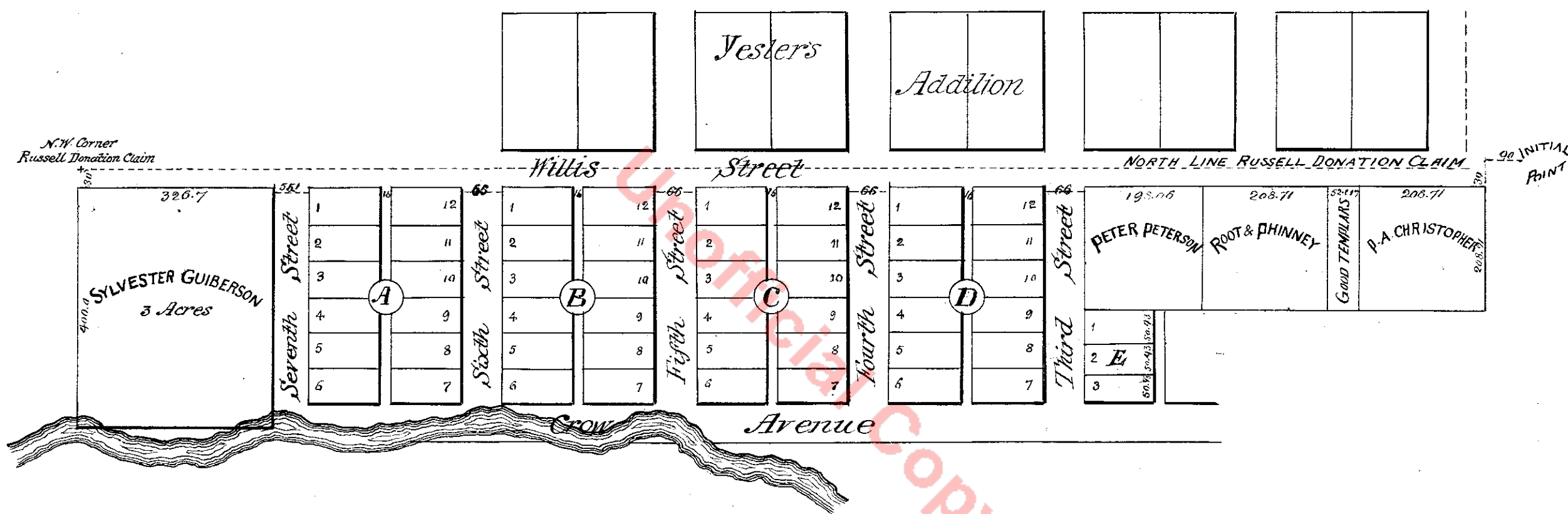

EXPLANATION

Crow's First Addition To The Town Of Kent is situate in Section 24 Township 22 North Range 4 East, Willamett Meridian, Washington Territory, as defined by this plat.

Blocks are 256' x 360', except block E which is 120' x 151.29'.

Lots are 60' x 120', except in block E where they are 50.43' x 120'.

Streets are 66' wide, except Willis Street which is 60' and seventh which is 55'.

The Initial Point of this plat is the intersection of the North line of Russell's Donation Claim with the center line of the Columbia & Puget Sound Railway.

DEDICATION
