

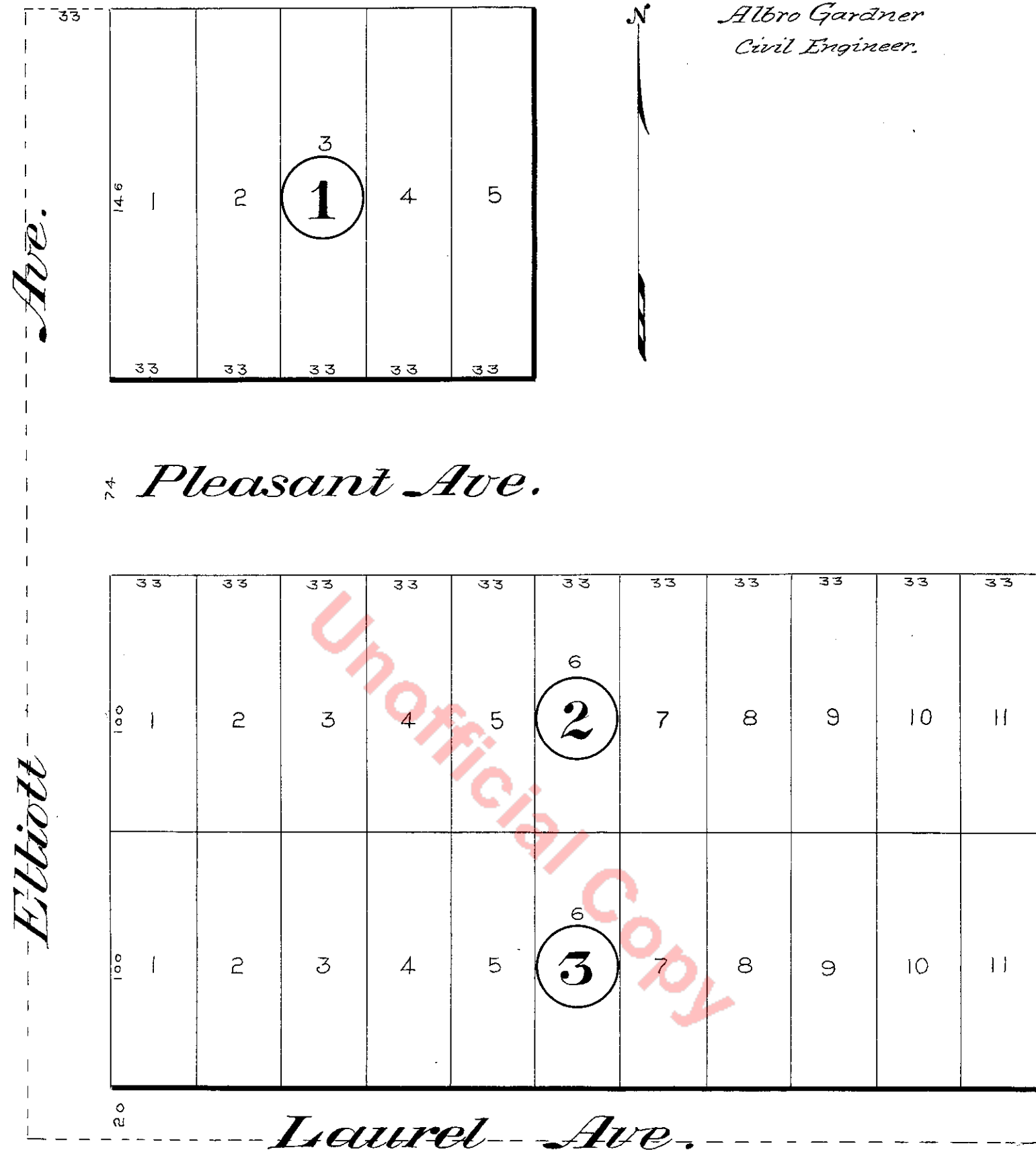

### Description

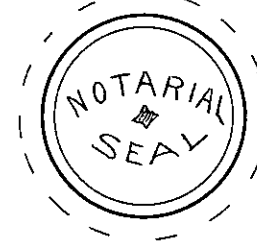
This Plat of "Queen Anne 3<sup>rd</sup> Addition to the City of Seattle" covers all of the following described tract of land: Commencing at the NW corner of the S.W. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Sec. 24 Twp. 25 N. R. 3 E. T. 11. Thence South 440 feet, thence East 396 ft. thence North 220 ft. thence West 198 ft. thence North 220 ft. thence West 198 ft. to the place of beginning.  
All lots are as shown.  
The widths of Avenues are as shown.  
The Initial Point is the NW Cor. of Block 1 which is 33 ft. East of the point of Commencement.
