

# CLARK'S First Addition

## To the Town of **KENT** Wash.

### DESCRIPTION.

This "Clark's First Addition To The Town of Kent, Wash." comprises a tract of land in the N.W. quarter of the N.W. quarter of Section 19, Township 22, North, Range 5 East, Willamette Meridian, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the N.E. corner of the said N.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of said Section 19, said corner being the Initial Point of this plat, and running S. 88° 15' W., along the Section Line between Sections 18 and 19 of said Townships and Range, five hundred seventy-one (571) feet; thence S. 0° 25' E. nine hundred thirty-eight and twenty-five hundredths (938.25) feet; thence N. 89° 01' E. five hundred seventy-one and five tenths (571.5) feet; thence N. 0° 25' W., along the divisional line between the N.W. 1/4 and the N.E. 1/4 of said Section 19, nine hundred forty-five and sixty-four hundredths (945.64) feet to point of beginning, containing about twelve and thirty-one hundredths (12.31) acres. The size of lots, width of Alleys, streets and Avenue are as shown on the above plat.

### DEDICATION.

Know all men by these presents, that we, William Clark and his wife, Laura S. Clark, owners in fee simple of the above named "Clark's First Addition to the Town of Kent, Wash.," do hereby dedicate to the use of the public forever all the Avenue, streets and Alleys, platted therein.

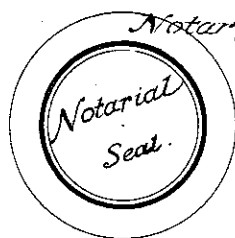
