

# The Byron Addition to the City of Seattle

## Description.

This plat of the Byron Addition to the City of Seattle embraces the whole of the North East quarter of the North East quarter of Sec. 16 Twp. 24 North, Range 4 East, W.M. The sizes of lots and blocks and the width of streets, Avenues and alleys are as shown on the face of this plat in feet.

The initial point of the plat is the North East corner of Block 1, which is the North East corner of said section 16, Twp. 24 N. R. 4 E. W.M.

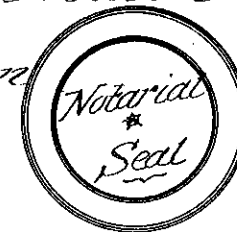
