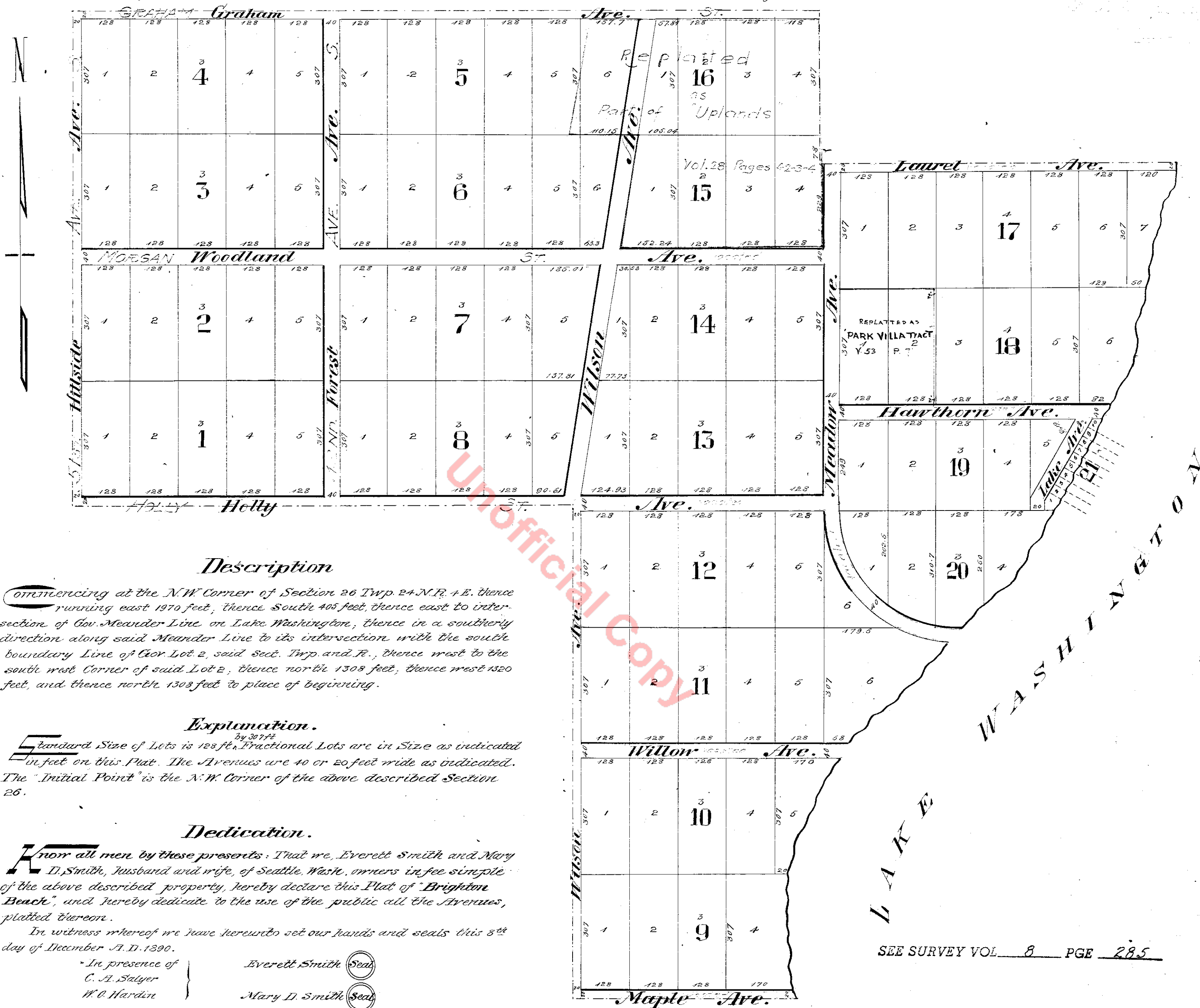


# Map of Brighton Beach King Co.

### Description

Commencing at the NW Corner of Section 26 Twp. 24 N. R. 4 E. thence running east 1970 feet, thence South 405 feet, thence east to intersection of Gov. Meander Line on Lake Washington, thence in a southerly direction along said Meander Line to its intersection with the south boundary line of Gov. Lot 2, said Sect. Twp. and R., thence west to the south west corner of said Lot 2, thence north 1308 feet, thence west 1320 feet, and thence north 1308 feet to place of beginning.

### Explanation.

Standard Size of Lots is 128 ft. Fractional Lots are in Size as indicated in feet on this Plat. The Avenues are 40 or 20 feet wide as indicated. The Initial Point is the N.W. Corner of the above described Section 26.

### Dedication.

Know all men by these presents: That we, Everett Smith and Mary D. Smith, husband and wife, of Seattle, Wash., owners in fee simple of the above described property, hereby declare this Plat of "Brighton Beach", and hereby dedicate to the use of the public all the Avenues, platted thereon.

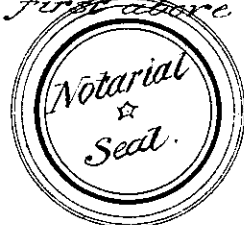
