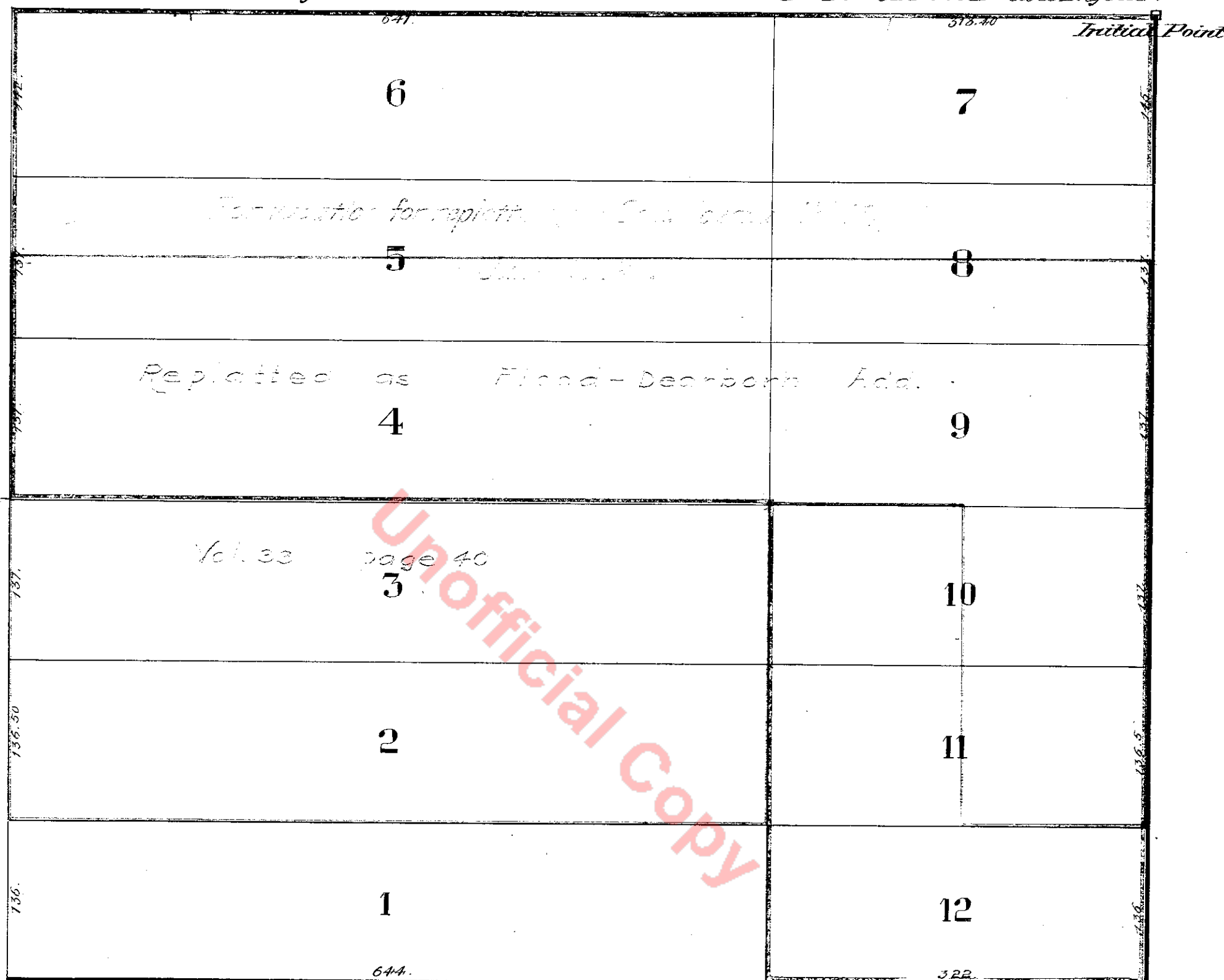


FLOODS ACRE GARDENS

Description.

This Plat of "Floods Acre Gardens" is described as follows: - Commencing at the corner of Sections 13 & 24 in Twp. 24 N. R. 4 E. W.M. and Secs. 18 & 19 Twp. 24 N. R. 5 E. thence due West on the line between said Secs. 13 & 24 to the Shore of Lake Washington, thence South along the Shore of Lake Washington to a point 493.32 ft. North of the East and West line between lots N^o 6 & 7 in said Sec. 24, thence due East to the East line of said Sec. 24, thence North on said Sec. line to the point of beginning.

The Initial point is the N.E. corner of Lot 7 on this plat, which is the N.E. corner of the tract.
