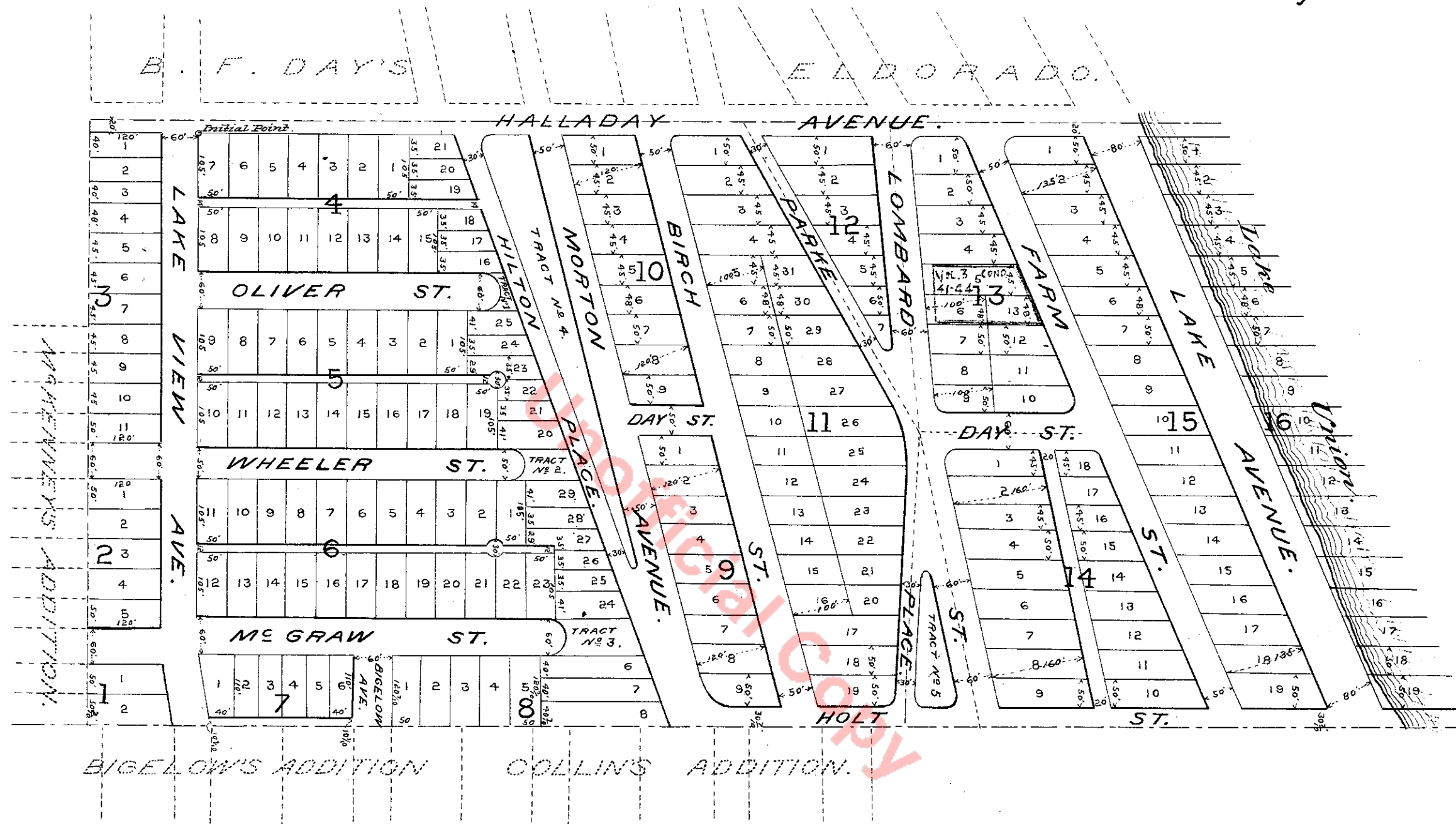


# HUNTER'S LAKE UNION ADDITION

### Explanation.

This Hunter's Lake Union Addition to the City of Seattle comprises the following tract of land, to wit:— Beginning at a point five and fifty hundredths (5 $\frac{5}{100}$ ) chains south of the S.W. corner of lot No. two (2) section nineteen (19) Township twenty five (25) N. R. four (4) E. W. M. King County, Washington, and running thence East along a line parallel to and uniformly five and fifty hundredths (5 $\frac{5}{100}$ ) chains south of the south boundary line of said lot two (2) to the shore line of Lake Union, thence southerly along said shore line to the south line of lot No. three (3) in said section, thence West along the south line of said lot No. three (3) and also along the south line of the S. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  in said section nineteen (19) to the S. W. corner of said S. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  in said section nineteen (19) thence North along the west line of said S. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said N. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  nine hundred seventy eight and seven tenths (978 $\frac{7}{10}$ ) feet to the place of beginning, containing thirty six and seventy five hundredths (36 $\frac{75}{100}$ ) acres more or less. The initial Point of this plat is the N. W. corner of lot 7 block 4 which is 383 feet south of and 180 feet East of S. W. corner of lot No. 2 in section 19. All dimensions are fully indicated upon the plat.

### Dedication.

I, Morton C. Hunter (owner) do hereby declare this plat and do hereby dedicate to the use of the public forever all the streets, Avenues, Places and Alleys shown thereon, excepting and reserving however all my riparian and littoral rights on said premises for my own use and benefit.
