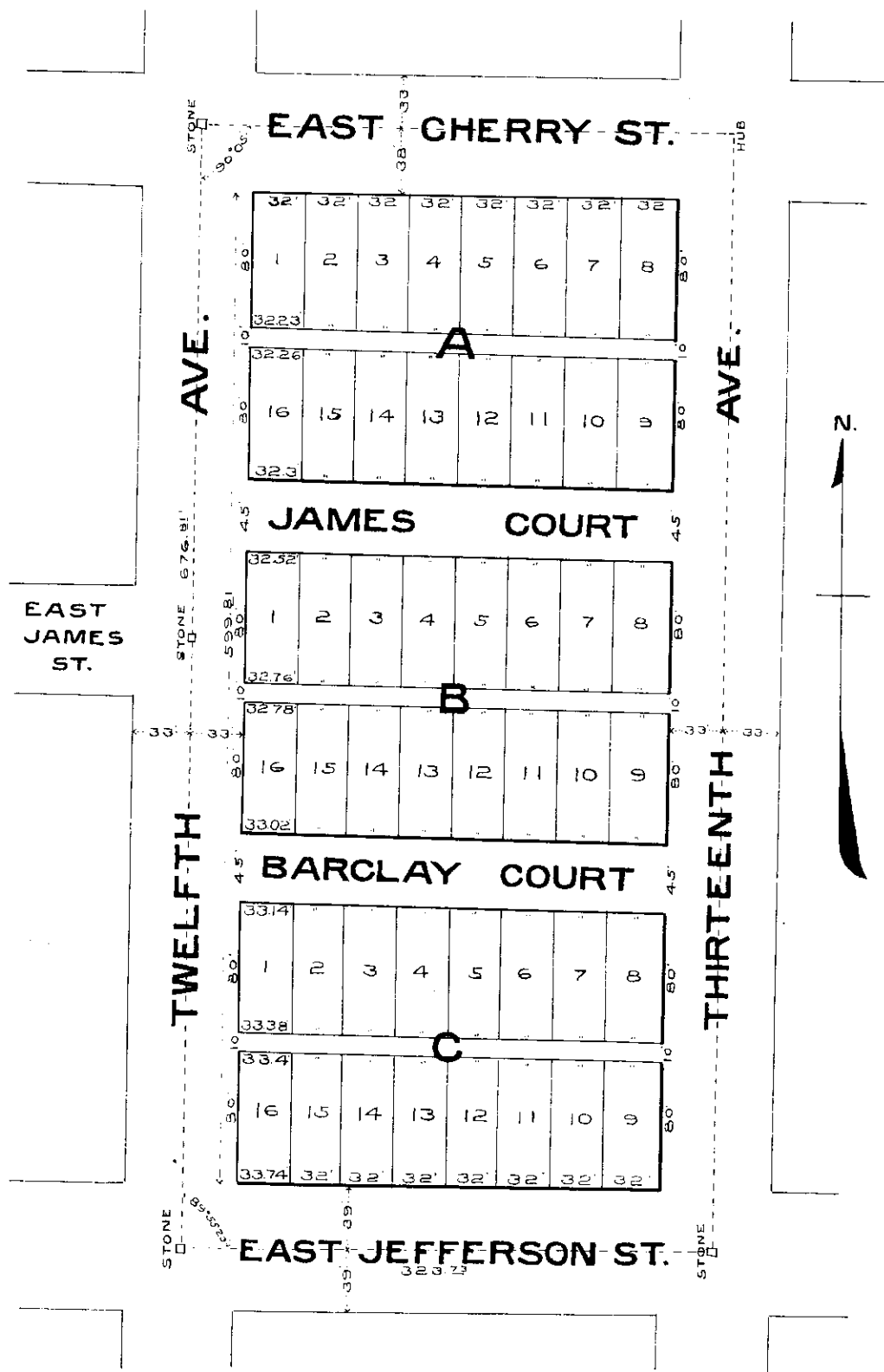


W.C. Squire's Replat

LEGEND.

This Plat comprises Block 8 of Squire Park Addition to the City of Seattle; The Marginal lines of 12 Ave. (formerly 14 Ave.) and 13 Ave. (formerly 15 Ave.) and East Jefferson Street (formerly Remington Avenue) and East Cherry - (formerly Willow Street.) are the Marginal lines of the said Streets and Avenues as located and established by the City of Seattle.

The City Monuments in the Streets and Avenues are shown on the Plat and the distances to the Block lines.

Barclay Court and James Court are each 45 feet wide. The Alleys are 10 feet wide. All Lots are 32' x 80' except as different dimensions are shown on the Plat.

DEDICATION.

Know all men by these presents that we W. C. Squire and Ida R. Squire his wife the owners in fee simple of Block 8 of Squire Park Addition to Seattle hereby Replat the same in accordance with this Plat and hereby dedicate to the use of the Public forever, Barclay and James Courts and the Alleys shown in Blocks A, B, C.

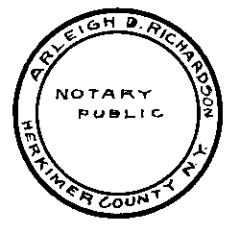

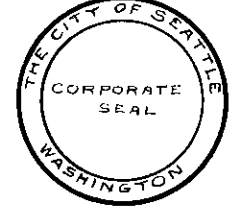
