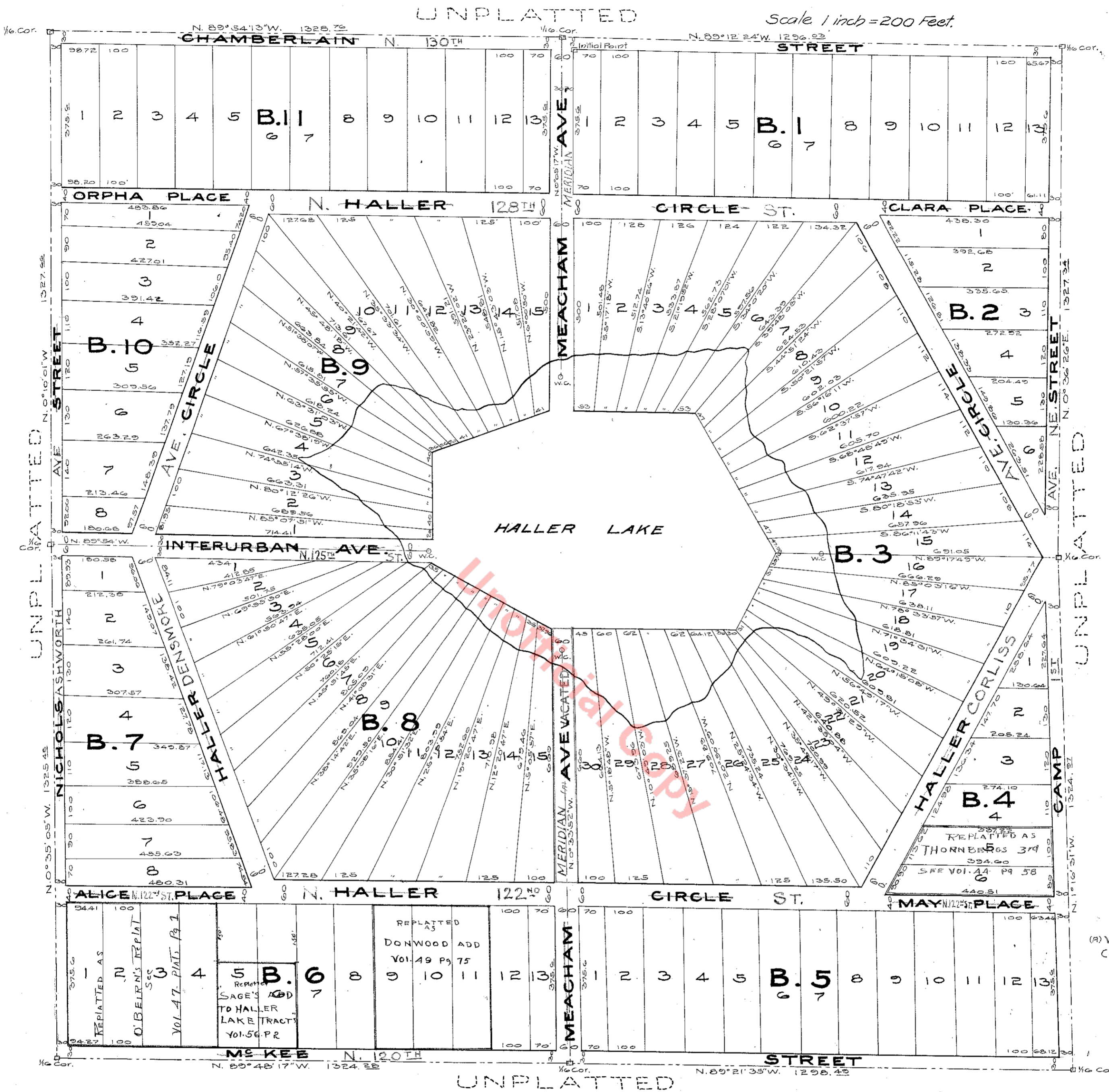

### DESCRIPTION

This Plot of Haller Lake Tracts, King County Wash., comprises the S.E. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of Section 19, and the S.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 20, and the N.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 29, and the N.E. 1/4 of the N.E. 1/4 of Section 30, in Township 26 North and Range 4 East of W. M. all in King County, State of Washington.

The Initial Point is the N.W. corner of Lot 1 of Block 1, which is 30 feet east of and 30 feet south of the N.W. corner of the said S.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 20.

The dimensions of all the Lots, Blocks and Streets are shown on the Plat.
