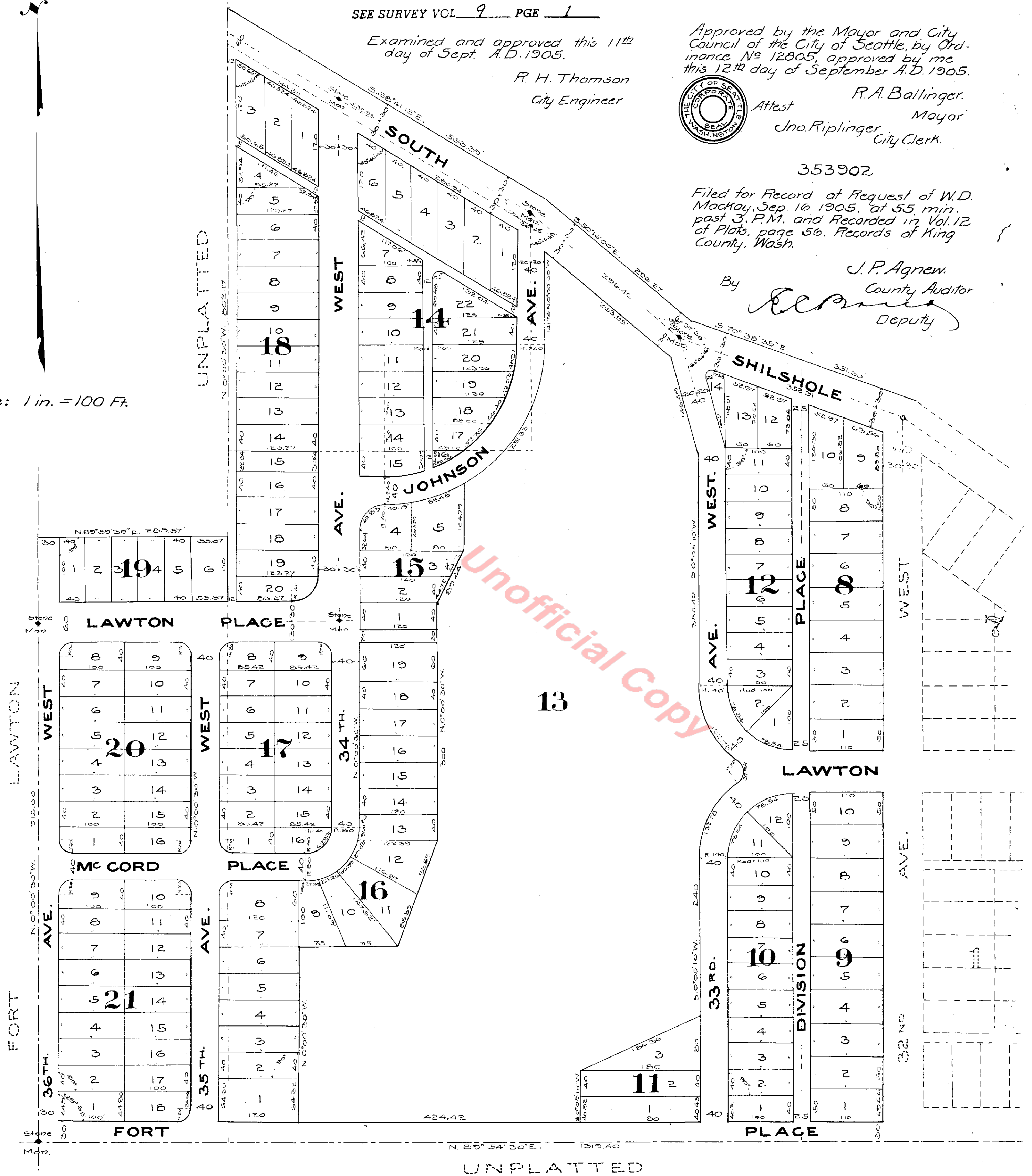

## THE CITY OF SEATTLE

### DESCRIPTION

This plot of "LAWTON PARK", an Addition to the City of Seattle, comprises the following described tract of land to-wit:— Commencing at the South-west corner of Lot 6 of Section 10 of Township 25 North, of Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian in King County, State of Washington, thence N.0°00'30"W. along the West line of said Lot 6 - 945.00 feet, thence Easterly along a line parallel to the South Boundary line of said Lot 6 - 285.57 feet, thence N.0°00'30"W. along a line parallel to the West boundary line of said Lot 6 - 802.17 feet, thence S.58°41'15"E. 553.39 feet, thence S.50°16'00"E. 233.27 feet, thence S.70°38'35"E. 351.30 feet, thence S.54°01'35"E. 1006.76 feet, thence S.89°54'50"E. 401.79 feet to a point, thence S.0°00'50"E. 528.92 feet to a point on the South boundary line of Section 11 of said Township and Range 1212.40 feet easterly of the South-west corner of said Section 11, thence S.89°52'23"W. along the South boundary line of said Section 11 - 1212.40 feet to the South-West corner of said Section 11, thence S.89°54'30"W. 1319.40 feet to the place of beginning.

The dimensions of all Lots, Blocks, Street, Avenues, and Alleys Ways and Places are as shown on this plat. The courses shown hereon are referred to the Standard Meridian of the City of Seattle.

The Initial Point is the South-west corner of Lot 1 of Block 1, which point is 50 ft north of and 10 feet East of the stone monument common to Sections 10, 11, 14 and 15 of Township 25 North, of Range 3 East W.M. measured along lines parallel to the West and South boundaries of said Section 11.

In accepting this plat the city hereby relinquishes any rights it may have in any previous roads except those contained within the streets or roads ways herein platted.

### DEDICATION
