DESCRIPTION

This plat of Botanos Supplemental Addition to the City of Georgetown, Comprises the following tract of land to wit:—

Beginning at the South east Corner of tract Number (1) one Hortons First Subdivision to the City of Georgetown as shown in Vol nine(9) of plats page thirty four (34) records of King County Wash. Thence West along the division line between tracts No's one(1) and two(2) said Hortons First Subdivision to Georgetown three hundred twenty (320) feet more or less to the Easterly line of Mable Street as shown on the plat of Georgetown and recorded in Vol Six (6) Page nine(9) records of King County Wash.

Thence North 11°56' East along the Easterly line of Mable Street two hundred fifty five and seventy seven (255.77) feet;

Thence East parallel to the first course in this description two hundred sixty seven and eleven hundredths (267.11) feet more or less to the dividing line between the east and west one halves of the L. M. Collins Donation Claim.

Thence South along the said dividing line two hundred fifty and twenty four hundredths (250.24) feet more or less to the place of beginning

The initial point is the South East Corner of Lot nine(9) Block two (2) which is identical with the South East Corner of Tract one (1) Hortons First Subdivision.

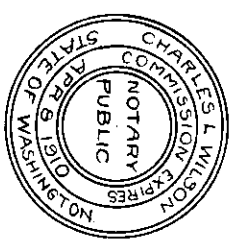
