

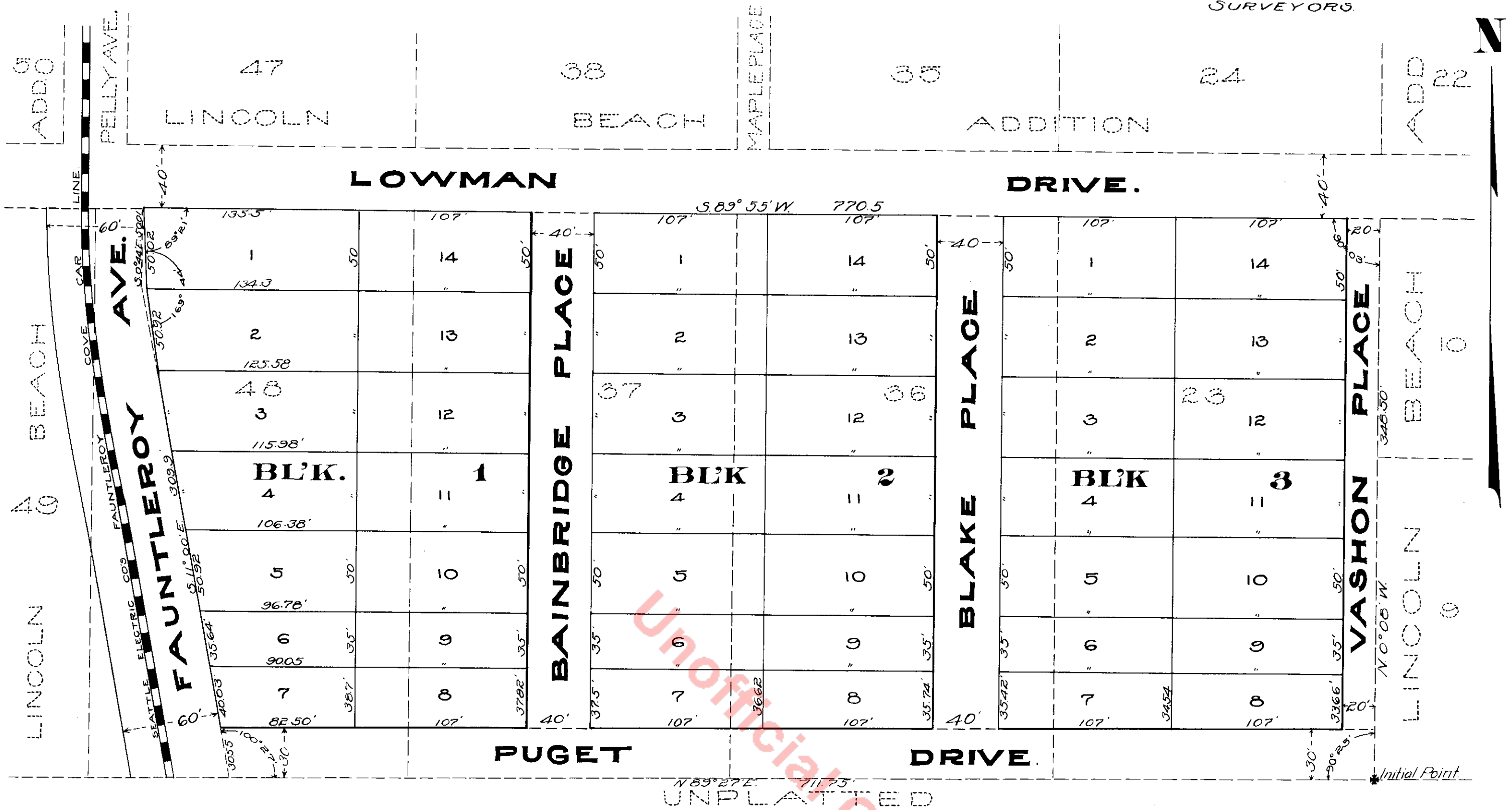
# Lincoln Home Addition

## DESCRIPTION

This plat of Lincoln Home Addition is a replat of lots 23-36-37 and that part of 48 lying east of the county road called Fautleroy Ave; all in Lincoln Beach Addition, King County, Washington. All courses are referred to the Willamite Meridian.

All distances are as shown on the face of plat.

The initial point of this survey is the S.E. Cor. of lot 23, identical with the S.W. Cor. of lot 9, both of Lincoln Beach Addition.

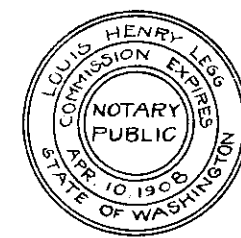
