

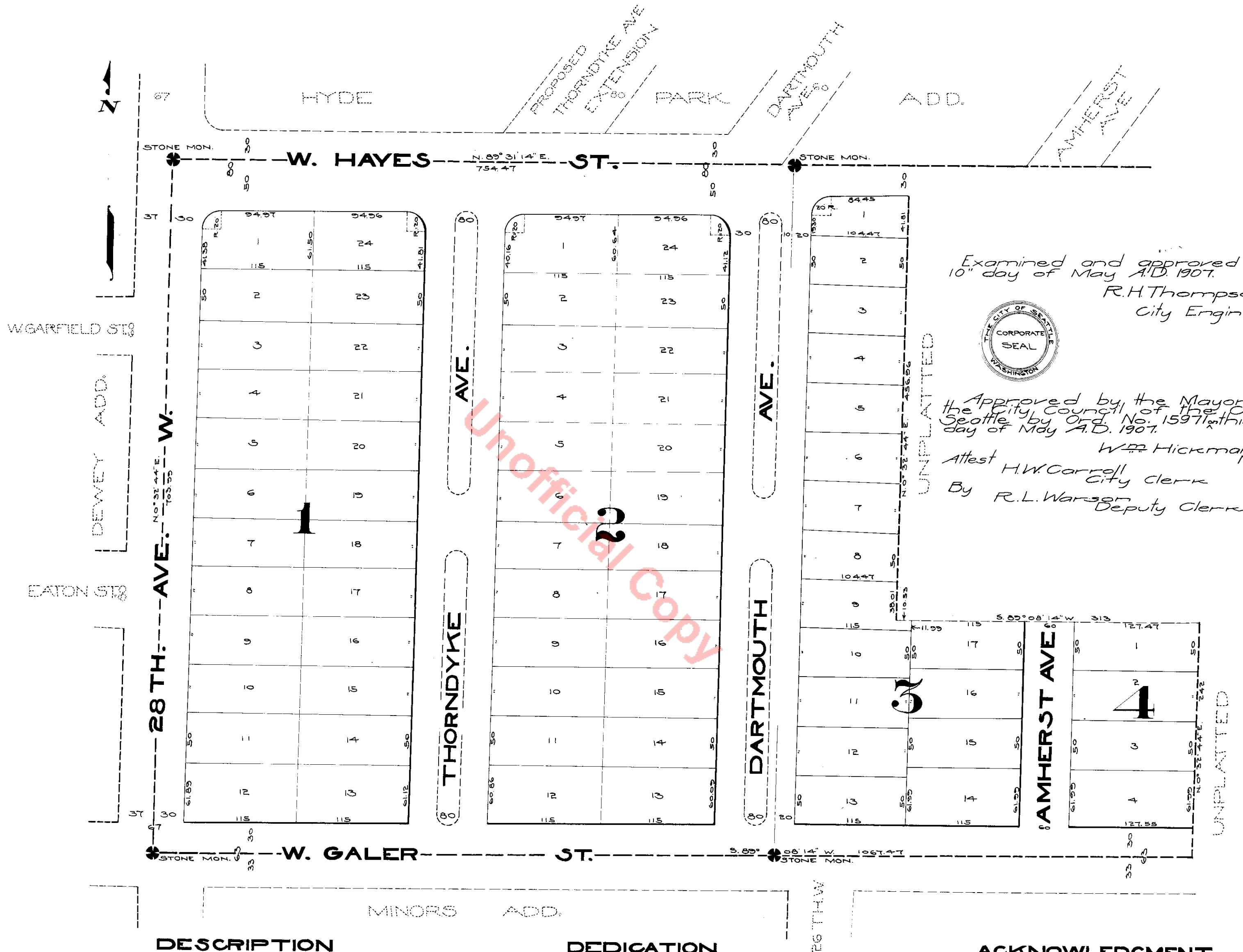

## DESCRIPTION

This plat embraces all of the S 1/2 of lot 4 in Sec 23 T. 25 N. R. 3 E. of W.M. containing 23.05 Acres, except the following described portion of said lot 4 to-wit:

Beginning at a point 210 ft. West of and 242 ft. North of the Government Meander Post, which post is the S.E. corner of lot 4, Section 23, T. 25 N. R. 3 E. W.M.; thence running West 313 ft.; thence running North 418 ft.; thence running East 313 ft.; thence running South 418 ft. to the place of beginning.

And containing 3 Acres herebefore conveyed to Dona Falls by deed dated March 11, 1887 and recorded in Vol. 40 of Deeds, pages 87 and 89 of the Records of King County, Wash. and also excepting the following described portion of lot 4, Section 23, T. 25 N. R. 3 E. W.M. to-wit:

Beginning at the Government Meander post, which is the S.E. corner of Lot 4, Section 23, T. 25 N. R. 3 E. W.M. and running thence west 210 ft.; thence North 660 ft. to a point on the division line between the South half and the North half of said Lot 4; thence east along said division line 412 ft. to the Government Meander Line; and thence in a South westerly direction along said Meander Line to the point of beginning, containing 4.75 Acres, more or less, heretofore conveyed to the Seattle Lake Shore and Eastern Railway Company by deed dated April 6th, 1887, and recorded in Volume 57 of Deeds, pages 397, 398 and 399 of the records of King County, Wash.

## DEDICATION

Know all men by these presents that the Magnolia Park Co. a corporation, owner in fee simple of the land above described and platted hereby declare this plat and dedicate to the use of the public forever all streets, avenues and alleys shown thereon.
