DESCRIPTION

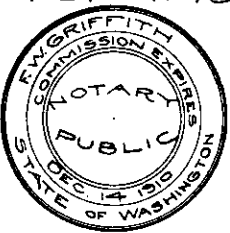
This plat of "Interurban Heights" embraces all of the following described tract of land to-wit:-
Beginning at the $\frac{1}{2}$ corner between Sections 16 and 21-Tp. 22 N.-R. 4 E. W.M. King Co. thence N. 89°10' E. 610.00 ft. thence S 0°50' E. 1267.00 ft. thence S 89°10' W. 610.00 ft. thence N 0°50' W. 1267.00 ft. to the point of beginning.

All bearings are referred to the true meridian
