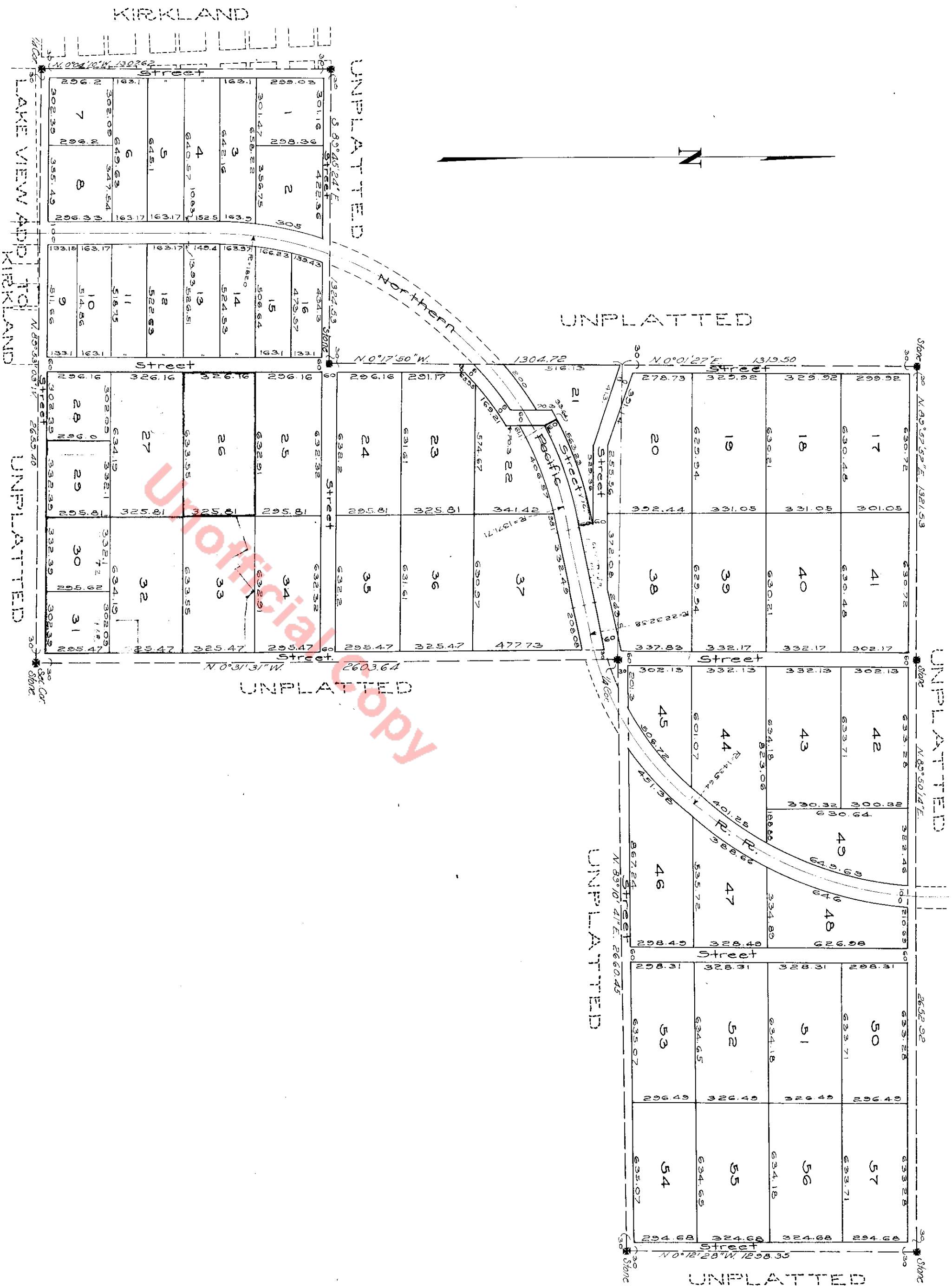

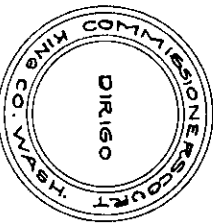


### DESCRIPTION

All distances are as shown on this plat in feet.

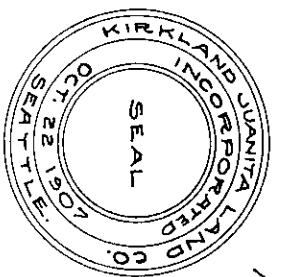

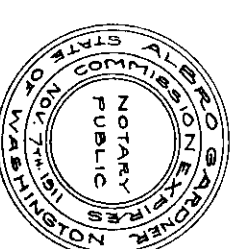
