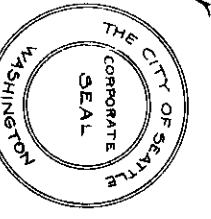


**DESCRIPTION**

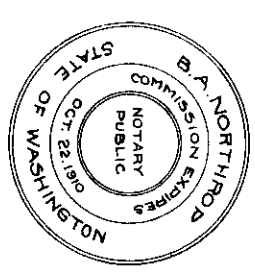
