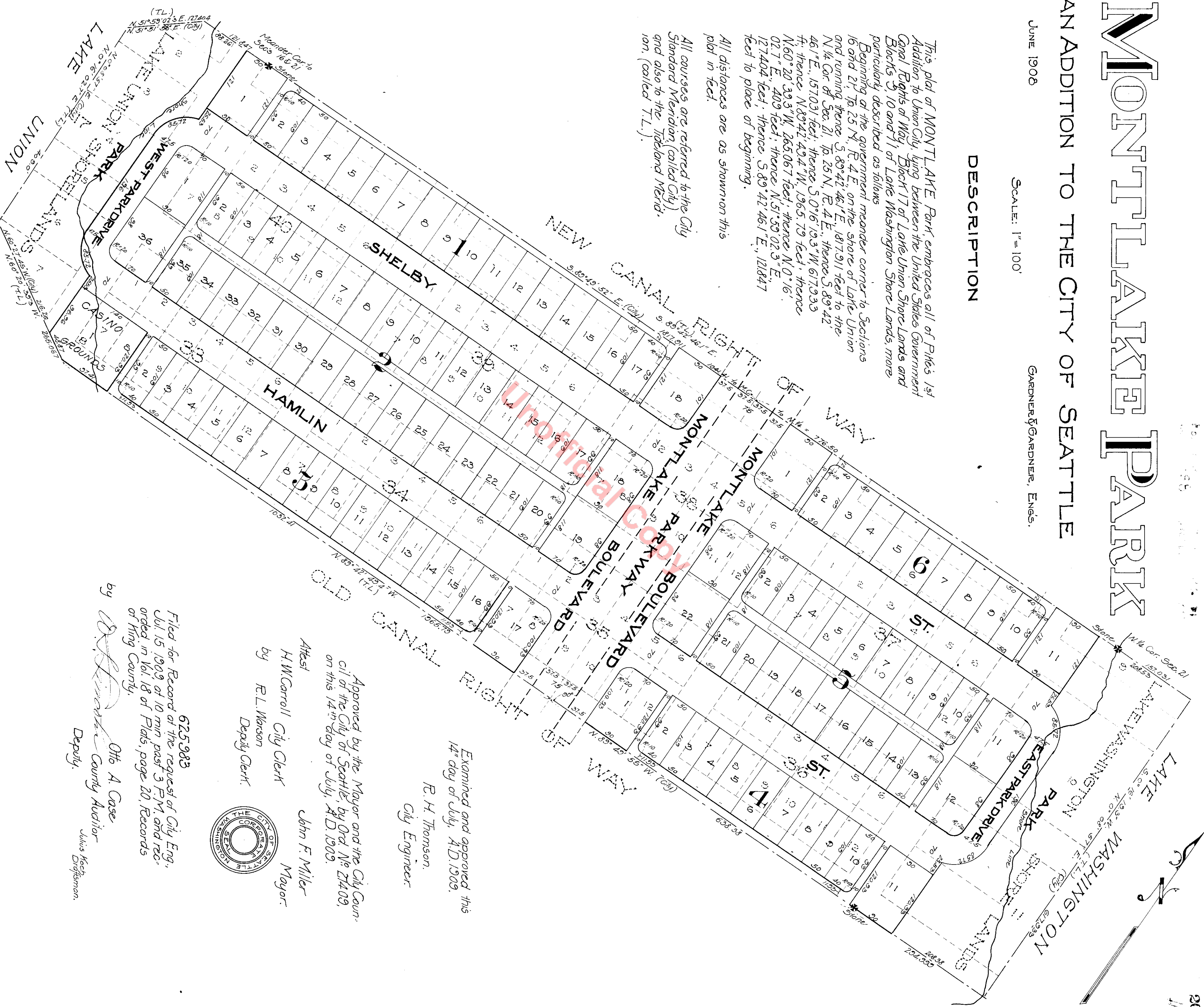
DESCRIPTION

This plat of MONTLAKE Park embraces all of Plats 1st Addition to Union City, lying between the United States Government Canal, Rights of Way, Block 17 of Lake Union Shore Lands and Blocks 9, 10 and 11 of Lake Washington Shore Lands, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the government meander corner to Sections 16 and 21, T₂₅N., R₄E., on the shore of Lake Union and running thence S. 89° 42' 46.1" E., 187.911 feet to the N 1/4 Cor. of Sec. 21, T₂₅N., R₄E., thence S. 89° 42' 46.1" E., 157.031 feet; thence S. 0° 16' 13.3" W., 617.933 feet; thence N. 89° 42' 46.1" W., 1965.79 feet; thence N. 60° 22' 39.3" W., 265.067 feet; thence N. 0° 16' 02.1" E., 409 feet; thence N. 51° 59' 02.3" E., 127.404 feet; thence S. 89° 42' 46.1" E., 128.847 feet to place of beginning.

All distances are as shown on this plat in feet.

All courses are referred to the City Standard Meridian (called City) and also to the Tiedland Meridian, (called T.L.).



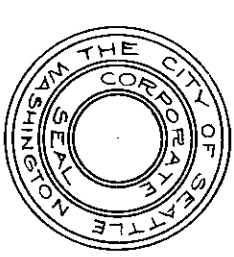
