

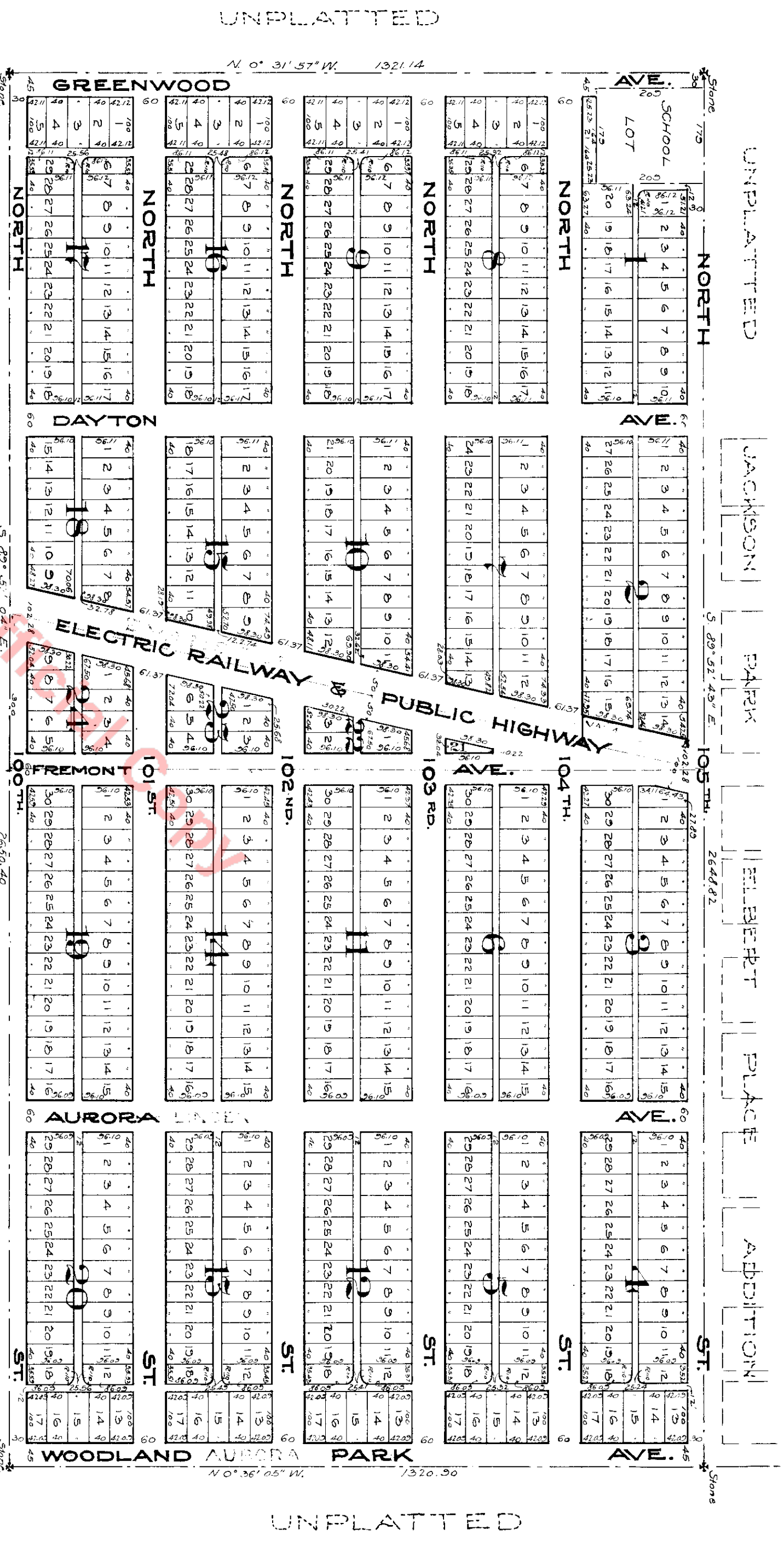
# NORTHER PARK

## DESCRIPTION

This plat of North Park an Addition to the City of Seattle, embraces the N 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 31, T. 26 N., R. 4 E., W. 1 W., except one acre in the NW corner described as follows:

Beginning of the NW corner of Sec. 31, T. 26 N., R. 4 E., thence East 209 ft., thence South 209 ft., thence West 209 ft., thence North 209 ft., to the place of beginning and subject to the easement of the public highway, 30 ft. more or less in width on the West side of the above described tract.

Also except a strip 50 ft. wide on each side of the center line of the right-of-way, of an electric railway and public highway, beginning at a point 300 ft. West of the Southeast corner of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Sec., thence N. 12° 43' 10" E. to the N.E. corner of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of said Sec.

All distances are as shown on this plat in feet.

We hereby certify that the plat of North Park is based upon an actual survey and subdivision of Sec. 31, T. 26 N., R. 4 E., W. 1 W., that the distances and courses as shown thereon are correct. That monuments have been set upon the grounds indicated upon the face of this plat.

## DEDICATION

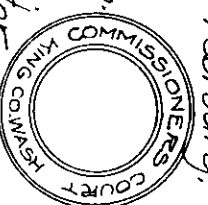
