

DESCRIPTION

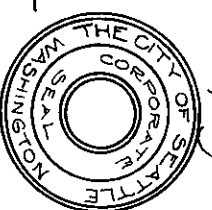

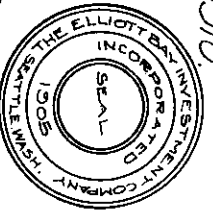
DEDICATION
