Description.

This plat of "Golden View" an addition to the City of Seattle covers and embraces all of Lot three (3) in Section Thirty Five (35), Township Twenty Six (26) North, Range Three (3) East of the Willamette Meridian. Excepting that portion occupied and used by the Great Northern Railway Company as Railroad Right of Way.

All dimensions are as shown upon the face of the plat in feet.
All bearings are referred to the Standard Meridian of the City of Seattle.

I hereby certify that the plat of "Golden View" an addition to the City of Seattle is based upon an actual survey and subdivision of Section 35, T. 26 N., R. 3 E., W. M., that the distances, courses and angles are shown thereon correctly, that the monuments have been set and lot and block corners staked upon the ground.

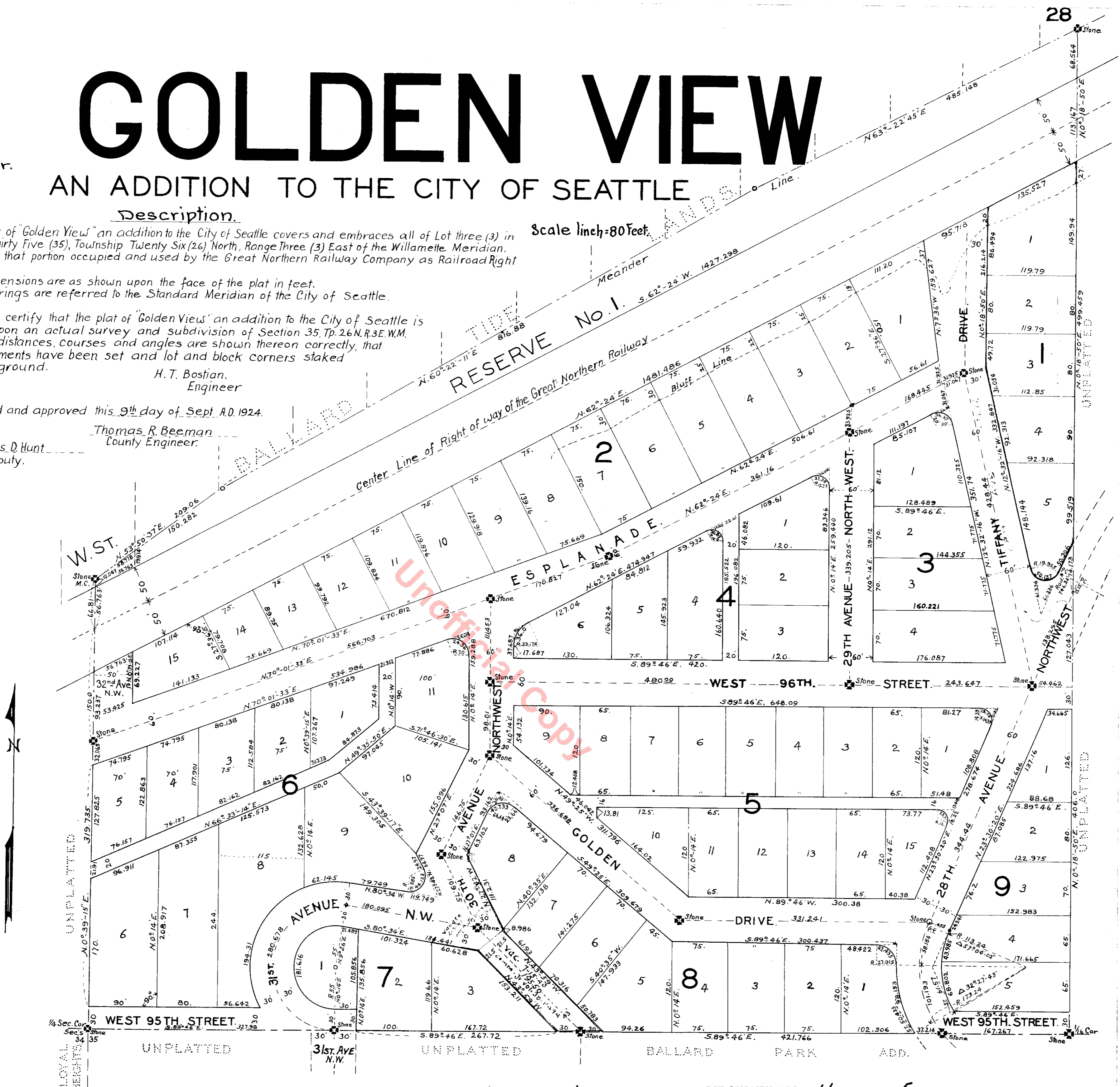

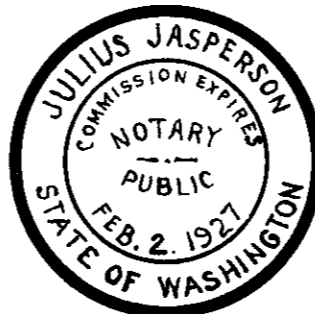
